Subject: WPG 2019 Rates Notification

Neenah, WI – After having no rate increase in 2018, the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin Paper Group, parent company of WPG Shippers Association, have approved a 2019 budget that requires a nominal rate increase due to the cumulative effects of additional shipping costs nationwide.

The transportation industry has been saddled by recent regulations resulting in increased operating cost and reduced capacity. To offset this nationwide escalation of shipping and freight cost, WPG must equalize the ways and means of these incremental costs as mandated by our charter.

WPG's not-for-profit status requires management to function annually within a zero based balanced budget. We will incorporate the approved rate schedule into an updated WPG 2019 Rules Tariff with an effective date of January 13, 2019.

The Wisconsin Paper Group was established in 1934, uniquely formed as a not-for-profit shippers association. Now in our ninth decade, WPG continues to offer its members reduced transportation cost, improved service, logistics support, value-added services and the distribution management of various products to points across North America.
